Last year one of the founders of the WHS, Jean Rideout, passed away. Jean and her husband Walter helped organize the WHS in the early 1990s recruiting Ruthann Dahl, Bernie Treichel and a few other "gardening friends". The Rideouts diligently collected all the known cultivars that Eunice Fischer hybridized for a bed at Olbrich which they faithfully tended over the years. They continued to be "guiding lights" for WHS, as President and VP, sharing their vast knowledge of hosta cultivars and networking within the regional and national Hosta Societies. They were actively involved in the community as well as the plant world.

In tribute to the skillful founding foresight and dedicated service of Jean Rideout, the Wisconsin Hosta Society has donated \$500 to the UW Friends of the Arboretum in her memory. Her gentle spirit and the cordial sharing of her (and Walter's) lovingly tended gardens on their Seminole Highway hillside are among the memories of the long-standing members of this Society.


